Year 7, Reception and Nursery applications for September 2019

Reception & Year 7

For admission into Reception and Year 7 application is made via the Local Authority and their Preference Form has to be completed. The Local Authority will issue an Admission Policy booklet for Primary and Secondary which will contain BHTA admissions procedure.

To apply to Birkenhead High School Academy, parents or carers of prospective students will need to complete and return:

1. The Preference Form/ Common Application Form provided by Wirral Children's Services or other local authorities
2. The Non-Verbal Reasoning Assessment will take place on Saturday 24th November 2018 between 9.30am and 10.30am. The Music Aptitude Test will take place between 10.45am and 11.15am

Nursery & Sixth Form.

Applications can be obtained from the school office and are made direct to the Academy. Current parents who are interested in their daughter attending must complete the application form, even though they may have a daughter currently in the school

Application forms will be available in the Summer term for entry to Year 7 and Nursery for entry in September 2019. Please do not submit any further supplementary forms as these cannot be considered after the closing date.

Places in **Year 7** will be offered by the Local Authority on 1st March 2019. We do not publish the results of the Non Verbal Reasoning Assessment test which will be held in November 2018 as these are for banding purposes only. The Music Aptitude test results are not issued.

Places in **Reception** Class will be offered by the Local Authority in April 2019. Places in Nursery will be offered in January 2019.

At the present time there are no vacancies at this academy in any years including the Junior Department. If you are considering moving your child from their current school, you should contact Children & Young People's Department, Wirral on 0151 606 2000. They will be able to advise you about vacancies in other schools.

It is imperative that all prospective parents follow the correct procedures outlined in our Admissions Policy and the Primary/Secondary Education booklets which can be downloaded from the Wirral Education Local Authority website.
