Features

A distinctive attribute or aspect of something.

Representing things in a way that is accurate and true to life.

Unrealistic / Abstract

Representing things in a way that is not necessarily the way they look in reality.

Self Portrait

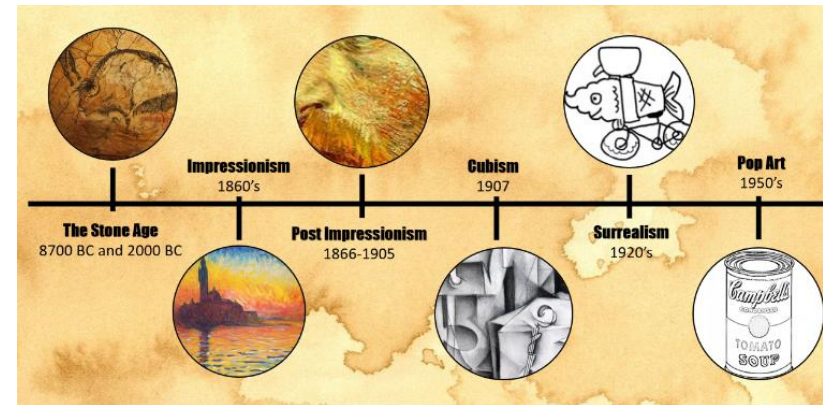
A portrait that an artist produces of themselves.

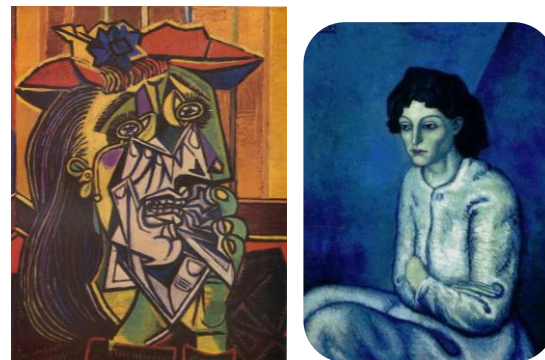


Using a colour wheel to mix primary colours to create secondary colours. Using primary and secondary colours to make tertiary colours.

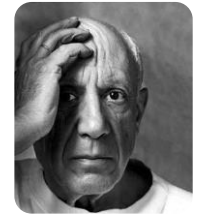
Picasso was a Spanish artist and is one of the most famous artists in the world.
