Timeline-when did this happen?

Jesus was born just over 2000 years ago. It is estimated that Jesus started preaching (teaching) between AD 27–29 and he was crucified between AD 30–36. Exact ages are unknown but it is believed that Jesus was about 30 when he started preaching and between 33–40 when he died.

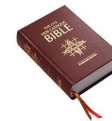
Spiritual – Children to reflect on the beliefs and practices of people who celebrate Easter.
