Timeline-when did this happen?

Judaism is one of the world's oldest religions, dating back nearly 4,000 years. Followers of Judaism believe in **one** God who revealed himself through ancient prophets.

Jesus was born just over 2000 years ago. The Nativity Story states he was born in a stable in Bethlehem. The Christian religion began following the crucifixion of Jesus in the 1st century AD.

- Know that Bar and Bat Mitzvahs mark the move for Jewish young people from childhood towards adulthood.
- Know that baptism is an important sign of belonging.
- Identify and suggest meanings for religious symbols and begin to use a range of religious words.
