**Puppeteer** – a person who operates a puppet.

### Types of puppets:

**Marionette** – marionettes are puppets controlled by strings.

**Sock puppets** – sock puppets are made from socks. They are moved by someone's hand.

**Hand/Glove puppet** – hand puppets are made out of fabric and are controlled by someone's hand.

**Finger puppets** – finger puppets are made of fabric, often felt. They are controlled by someone's finger.

**Rod puppet** – rod puppets are controlled by a wooden stick.
