Types of puppets:

Marionette – marionettes are puppets controlled by strings.

Sock puppets – sock puppets are made from socks. They are moved by someone's hand.

Hand puppet – hand puppets are made out of fabric and are controlled by someone's hand.

Finger puppets- finger puppets are made of fabric, often felt. They are controlled by someone's finger.

Rod puppet – rod puppets are controlled by a wooden stick.
