
Key Vocabulary:

Beatitude – being highly blessed

Rules – instructions or guidance about how to do something e.g. how to behave at school

Temptation - the desire to something, especially something wrong or unwise

How did it begin?

It is recorded in the Torah (Jewish holy book) that God gave Moses two stone tables inscribed with the rules he wanted the Israelites to follow in the Promised Land. Later, described in the New Testament of the Christian Bible, Jesus tells his disciples the two most important commandments. Jesus also described how he wanted his followers to live in the Sermon on the Mount; this message is called The Beatitudes.

Today we all live by rules to ensure everyone can live together happily – e.g. school rules, the rules of the road, the Countryside Code, the rules of our country and international laws.

Temptation


Temptation is the desire to do something – usually appealing – which we know we shouldn't. We all face temptations each day... maybe wanting to watch inappropriate television, gossip, take something that doesn't belong to us, lie, cheat or argue. Religious teachings can give us strength to resist such temptations.

The Lord's Prayer includes the line 'Lead us not into temptation' asking God to help us to avoid being tempted to do the 'wrong thing'. We all make choices about the way we behave and whether we will follow the rules every day.

Important teachings:



The Beatitudes are a set of teachings and blessings that Jesus gave in the Sermon on the Mount in the Gospel of Matthew. They describe the foundation of the Christian faith. The purpose of the Beatitudes is to inspire Christians to live according to the traits Jesus describes.
